### **Grant Aid Criteria**

The Olave Baden-Powell Society will only support applications that contribute towards the achievement of WAGGGS' Strategic Goals and Objectives.

The Strategy is expressed in three Goals and the World level Objectives, listed below.

#### **Goal 1 ~ Leadership Development ~ Capacity Building**

1. Increase volunteer membership and participation at all levels
2. Increase number of young women in leadership positions at national, regional and world levels
3. Develop and strengthen strategic leadership competencies at national and international levels
4. Strengthen leadership development for young women

#### **Goal 2 ~ Strong and Growing Member Organizations ~ Revitalizing the Movement**

1. Strengthen the quality of Girl Guiding/Girl Scouting offered to girls and young women
2. Develop innovative practices that support the development of Associations
3. Develop strategic partnerships within and outside WAGGGS to strengthen the capacity of the organization at national, regional and world level
4. Increase membership of girls and young women
5. Strengthen Girl Guiding/Girl Scouting profile and impact in communities and at regional and world level

### **Goal 3 ~ The Voice of Girls and Young Women ~ Building a better world**

1. Research and understand the needs and aspirations of girls and young women in the 21st century
2. Increase opportunity for girls and young women to engage in issues affecting their lives
3. Advocate and take action on specific issues at national, regional and world level
4. Increase visibility and influence of WAGGGS and its Members.

#### **Applications for grants to individuals will be considered within the following criteria:**

1. Priority will be given to young women under the age of 30.
2. Assistance will only be given to young women who are involved in Girl Guiding/Girl Scouting.
3. The application **must be** supported by a Girl Guiding/Girl Scouting leader.
4. Applicants are expected to make a personal contribution to the costs of the event/activity, and/or fundraise.
5. Successful applicants are expected to submit a **short report/feedback form (250 words) and photos** of their experiences for inclusion in the Annual Review of the OB-PS or other publicity, within **three months of** the event.
6. Grants will be in the range of £100 - £400.
