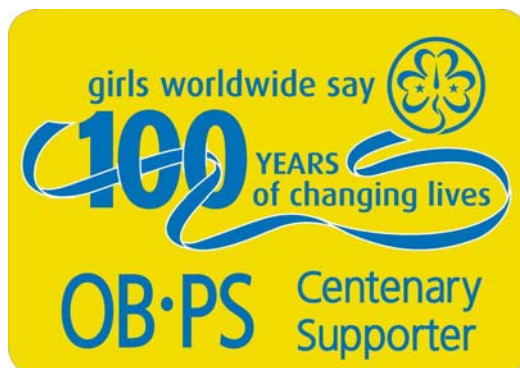

AN EXCITING NEW OPPORTUNITY THE CENTENARY SUPPORTER'S AWARD!

The Board of Directors of OB-PS would like to invite you to become a Centenary Supporter. This Award has been designed to coincide with the Centenary celebrations of Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting, and it will therefore only be available for a limited period of time - from 1 January 2009 until 2012.

It is very straight forward to become a Centenary Supporter. Any OB-PS member, having paid up her or his membership, may continue to contribute for a period of four years - ideally with £1,000 each year – in order to reach an additional total of £4,000. The Centenary Supporter's Award will commence on 1 January 2009, and should be completed during 2012 – which covers the period of the WAGGGS Centenary. As with the OB-PS membership and HRH Princess Benedikte Award, donations to other entities within WAGGGS/OB-PS will be accepted as contributing towards the Award. However, donations to Member Organizations will not be valid.

You can become Centenary Supporter in three ways:

- Annual donations of £1,000 (on top of the membership donation already paid) commencing in 2009, and concluding in 2012.
- One total donation of £10,000 for those without a previous OB-PS membership.
- Donations totalling £10,000 being made since 2000.
(If you feel that you have reached this level you will need to confirm with the OB-PS office how you have reached the total required).

Members who commit themselves to becoming a Centenary Supporter will be entitled to wear the Centenary Supporter's pin. You may use the form on the reverse to do this. When the total amount has been reached, and this should be not later than end of 2012, Centenary Supporters will receive a certificate, which will be presented to them at an Annual Event by HRH Princess Benedikte.
